Event Date and Description: [2011-06-20 Wear Your Seat Belt](#)

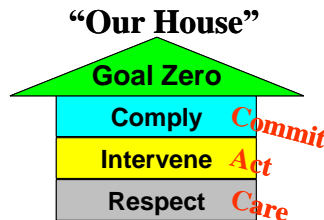
<u>What happened:</u> A commercial motor vehicle driver carrying a Shell load was cited for not wearing a seat belt.
<u>Which Life Saving Rule(s) involved:</u> Wear Your Seat Belt
<u>Investigation results:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. The individual was aware of the rules.2. The individual chose not to wear his seat belt3. The individual was cited by law enforcement for not wearing a seat belt.
<u>Action taken:</u> The individual was cited by law enforcement and terminated by the transport company.
<u>Key Learning Points:</u> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. If you choose not to obey the rules, you choose not to work for Shell.

It is about saving lives, and it is working.

Everyone should ensure that we know the rules, follow the rules, and always intervene if there is the potential for unsafe behaviors or conditions. This applies to everyone: peers, supervisors, and visitors.

If in doubt, always consult your supervisor.
