Event Date and Description: [2009-11-13 No alcohol or drugs while working or driving](#)

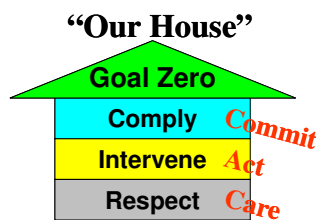
What happened: Two workers returned to a vessel after a lunch break and exhibited intoxicated behavior.
Which Life Saving Rule(s) involved: No alcohol or drugs while working or driving
Investigation results: The workers understood the rule and chose to consume alcohol during a lunch break and return to work intoxicated.
Action taken: Workers were removed from the location and no longer able to work for Shell
Key Learning Points: The rules are clear, if you choose not to follow the rules you choose not to work for Shell

It is about saving lives, and it is working.

Everyone should ensure that we know the rules, follow the rules, and always intervene if there is the potential for unsafe behaviors or conditions. This applies to everyone: peers, supervisors, and visitors.

If in doubt, always consult your supervisor.
